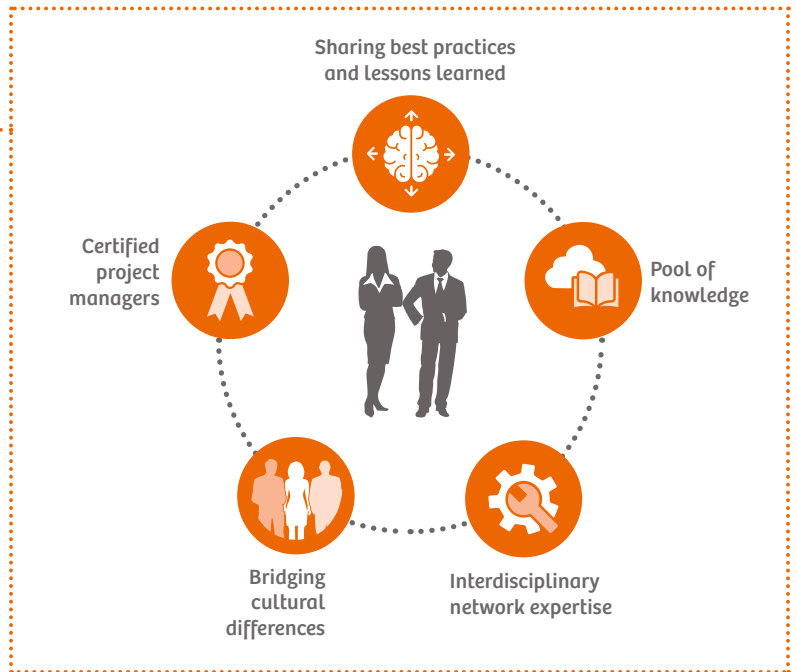
## Outsiders gain access to sensible data

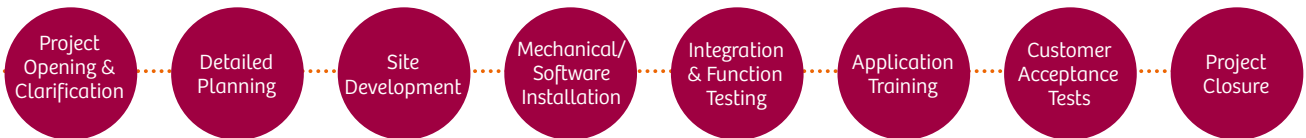
